

Ukai on the Ngaragawa and Kisogawa River.

You can watch the 1,300-year-old art of Ukai (cormorant fishing) on the **Nagaragawa River** and **Kisogawa River**, every evening between May 11 and October 15, except on the night of the harvest moon or when the water levels are too high. The ritual is performed by Usho (cormorant fishermen), whose art has been passed on through the generations by their ancestors. The perfect teamwork is a result of the fact that the men and the birds virtually live together, even when they are not fishing.
